<b>High School</b>	<b><i>What constitutes "life"?</i></b> Provide a short (less than 100 words) answer to this statement.
<b>Parents of Gifted Children</b>	<b><i>Living with a gifted child is...</i></b> Provide an artwork or short (less than 100 words) answer, poem, or story to this statement.
<b>Professionals</b>	<b><i>To Cluster or not to Cluster that is the question?</i></b> Provide an artwork or short (less than 100 words) answer, poem, or story to this statement.

## Prizes

Each winner will receive a \$50 book voucher and their winning entry will be published in a forthcoming edition of Tall Poppies, the magazine of the New Zealand Association for Gifted Children.
